THE DAN CALL MASKS 'GLE' OR 'GA' AND BELIEVE THEM TO BE MANIFESTATIONS OF WILD FOREST SPIRITS. THESE SPIRITS HAVE NO FORM, BUT WHEN THEY WISH TO USE THEIR POWERS TO SUPPORT MANKIND THEY MANIFEST THEMSELVES IN MAGICAL OBJECTS, LARGE RITUAL SPOONS OR MASKS. SPIRITS SELECT AN INDIMDUAL TO IMPERSONATE THEMBY APPEARING IN THEIR DREAMS AND THEN INFORMS THEM OF THE REQUIRED TYPE OF MASK, IT'S NAME, ACCOUTREMENTS, MUSICAL ACCOMPANIMENT AND DANCE STEPS (FISHER 1996; 486 – 90). THIS MASK KNOWN AS A BUGLE MASK WITH IT'S ORIGINAL FIBRE / HUMAN HAIR BEARD AND TUBULAR EYES HAS THE ATTRIBUTES OF A FEARSOME MALE SPIRIT AND WOULD HAVE ACCOMPANIED WARRIORS INTO BATTLE.
