TSONGA NECK RESTS ARE THE MOST VARIED IN THE DESIGN OF THEIR SUPPORT STRUCTURES IN ALL SOUTHERN AFRICA. THE TERRITORY OF THE TSONGA PEOPLES EXTENDS ACROSS THE BOUNDARIES OF SOUTHERN MOZAMBIQUE, SOUTH EASTERN ZIMBABWE AND THE NORTH EASTERN TRANSVAAL COMPLICATING ANY STUDY OF THE REGIONAL STYLISTIC VARIATIONS OF THEIR HEADRESTS.

HEADRESTS WERE VERY PERSONALIZED SPIRITUAL OBJECTS THAT BECAME SO MUCH A PART OF THEIR OWNER THAT ON DEATH, IN MOST INSTANCES, IT WAS BURIED WITH THEM. IN SOME RARE INSTANCES IT WAS KEPT AS A COMMUNICATING VEHICLE THAT COULD PROVIDE CONTACT WITH THE ANCESTOR.
