GREAT HORNBILLS HAVE ENORMOUS DOWN CURVED BILLS USUALLY SURMOUNTED BY A GROTESQUE HORNEY CASQUE AND CAN MEASURE UP TO 5 FEET LONG . THEY ARE NOT BEAUTIFUL BIRDS BUT ARE INTRIGUING , FASCINATING AND AMAZING IN THEIR UNIQUE HABITS . THEY MATE FOR LIFE AND ARE OFTEN REGARDED AS SYMBOLS OF PURITY AND FIDELITY .

THE DAYAK REGARD THE GREAT HORNBILL AS RELATED TO THE SOUL AND THE ANCESTRAL SPIRIT WORLD . THESE CAREFULLY CARVED WOODEN BIRD FIGURES WERE DISPLAYED IN FESTIVALS HONOURING THE GOD OF WAR AND AT CELEBRATIONS OF SUCCESSFUL HEAD HUNTING .
