EVERY PART OF THE ANIMAL WAS USED FOR FOOD OR FOR ANOTHER SPECIFIC PURPOSE. THE ARCTIC SEAS ARE SO COLD THAT THE MALE WALRUS CAN ONLY MATE BY MEANS OF A LARGE PENIS BONE, WHICH HAPPENS TO BE THE MOST NATURALLY AND PERFECTLY FORMED HAND-HELD CLUB.
