LITERATURE

THE BULL WAS A POWERFUL AMULETIC SYMBOL IN THE ARTS OF THE ANCIENT NEAR EAST. SCULPTED OUT OF A BEAUTIFUL PINKISH LIMESTONE AND THEN HIGHLY POLISHED, THE NATURALISTIC SCULPTURAL FORM IS SIMPLE, YET THE BULL IS BOLDLY EXECUTED AND PARTICULARLY IMPRESSIVE OF BOWNE POWER. THE DEEPLY INSET STARING EYES COMMAND THE MEWER'S ATTENTION AND CONVEY THE ESSENCE OF THE BULL. THESE VOTIVE PENDANTS PROBABLY SERVED AS AMULETS AS BY THE TIME THIS WAS MADE, WORKING SEALS HAD TAKEN THE FORM OF CYLINDERS, ALTHOUGH THE SHAPE AND FORM HARKS BACK TO AN AGE WHEN EARLIER MODELS WERE USED BOTH AS SEALS AND AMULETS.
