BY THE 15 TH AND 16 TH CENTURIES REFERENCES IN ENGLAND TO COCONUT CUPS, JUGS, AND FLASKS, OCCUR FAIRLY FREQUENTLY IN THE INVENTORIES OF THE NOBILITY. IN THE 18 TH CENTURY SALORS WERE CARVING EXAMPLES ON THEIR LONG VOYAGES HOME.
