COCONUTS, IN THEIR NATIVE LANDS WERE A NEVER ENDING CROP AND AS THE COMMONEST FORM OF EATING AND DRINKING VESSELS LITTLE LABOUR WAS USUALLY EXPENDED ON ORNAMENTING THEM. HOWEVER, AS EARLY IMPORTS TO EUROPE, JUST LIKE OSTRICH EGGS, THEY WERE GREAT RARITIES AND AS VALUABLE OBJECTS THEY WERE CARVED BY SKILLED CRAFTSMEN AND CONVERTED INTO SILVER MOUNTED GOBLETS AND CUPS, OR THE BODIES OF JUGS.
