MOUNTED CUPS, JUGS, AND BOWLS WERE POPULAR FROM EARLY MEDIAEVAL TIMES. WOOD, COCONUTS, OSTRICH EGGS, ROCK CRYSTAL, MOTHER OF PEARL, SERPENTINE AND RARE PORCELAIN FROM THE EAST, WERE ALL MADE INTO USEFUL OR ORNAMENTAL VESSELS BY THE ADDITION OF BRASS, SILVER OR GOLD MOUNTS. OFTEN HIGHLY PRIZED AS MAGICAL OBJECTS MADE OF RARE MATERIALS FROM FAR AWAY LANDS THESE ITEMS SURVIVED THE CENTURIES IN CABINETS OF CURIOSITIES.
