THE COSSACKS WERE HORSE RAISING GROUPS OF SOUTH - WEST RUSSIA , THE UKRAINE AND POLAND .

PREDOMINANTLY OF RUSSIAN AND UKRAINIAN ORIGIN WHO TOOK IN ESCAPED SERFS AND LIVED IN INDEPENDENT COMMUNAL SETTLEMENTS , FORMING A MILITARY BROTHERHOOD , FROM THE 15 TH TO THE 19 TH CENTURY . LATER ON THEY HELD LAND IN RETURN FOR MILITARY SERVICE IN THE CAVALRY UNDER RUSSIAN AND POLISH RULERS . AFTER THE RUSSIAN REVOLUTION THE VARIOUS COSSACK COMMUNITIES WERE INCORPORATED INTO THE SOVIET COLLECTIVE SYSTEM . THEIR PROWESS AT HORSE RIDING , FEATS OF MILITARY DARING , AND THEIR DANCING ARE LEGENDARY .
