THIS MARVELLOUS CARVED STRIATED ALABASTER FIGURE SEATED CROSS LEGGED WITH HIS HEAD UPLIFTED IN MEDITATION, HAS THE CHILDLIKE FACE OF THE STONE CARVINGS OF THE OLMEC'S, BUT IN THE SUBTROPICAL REGION OF THE MEXICAN CENTRAL GULF COAST AROUND VERA CRUZ A SEPARATE SOCIETY DEVELOPED WITH A DISTINCT CULTURE CALLED TAJIN. THESE FIGURES ARE FOUND AMONGST GRAVE OFFERINGS; A SIMILAR EXAMPLE TO THIS CAN BE FOUND IN THE BROOKLYN MUSEUM, NEW YORK.
