ERMELO IS ON THE BORDERS OF SWAZILAND 205 KILOMETRES FROM JOHANNESBURG AND WOULD HAVE BEEN AN AREA
INVOLVED IN THE SECOND ANGLO-BOER WAR OF 1899 – 1902 .

A CHARACTERISTIC OF THESE CHAIRS , OFTEN MADE BY TURNERS AND JOINERS WHO DOUBLED UP AS WAGON MAKERS
AND HOUSE WRITES , IS THE PROTRUSION OF THE FRONT LEG POSTS SLIGHTLY ABOVE THE SEAT RAILS WHICH WAS A
DEVICE TO KEEP LOOSE SEAT CUSHIONS USED AT THE TIME FROM SLIPPING .
