THE MUSEUM LABEL WITH THIS CLUB READS: 'THIS WEAPON WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR TWO MURDERS ON THE GOLD COAST ( GHANA ) IN 1920. A NATIVE RAN AWOK AND MURDERED HIS NEIGHBOUR, THEN TOOK SHELTER IN THE BUSH. A SERGEANT IN THE GOLD COAST DEFENCE FORCE WAS SENT TO ARREST HIM, BUT WAS HIMSELF BRUTALLY HIT ON THE HEAD AND HIS SKULL BROKEN. THE FORCE OF THE BLOW CAUSED THE SPLIT IN THE WOOD OF THE WEAPON. PRESENTED TO THE MUSEUM BY MRS E BRADDICK, WHOSE HUSBAND WAS DISTRICT COMMISSIONER.'
