LYON WORKED IN DUBLIN AND LIVERPOOL AS A SCULPTOR AND WAX MODELLER. WHILST HE WAS AT THE LIVERPOOL ACADEMY HE SHOWED A NUMBER OF WAX BUSTS IN FULL ROUND RELIEF OFTEN WITH LOOSELY FINISHED SHOULDERS. HIS BUST OF SIR WILLIAM CUSACK-SMITH (1834) FINELY EXECUTED IN AN IDENTICAL STYLE IS ILLUSTRATED IN E.J PYKE, BIOGRAPHICAL LEXICON OF WAX MODELLING NO. 180.
