THE ART OF THE PEOPLE OF THE NORTHWEST COASTAL AREA OF NEW GUINEA IS A REFINED MIX OF THE SOUTH EAST ASIAN INFLUENCES OF WESTERN NEW GUINEA AND THE MORE REMOTE FORMAL ART OF THE SEPIK RIVER . GEOGRAPHICALLY THE AREA COMPRISES A LONG STRETCH OF LOWLAND PLAINS INTERSPERSED WITH RIVERS RUNNING DOWN FROM THE MOUNTAINS , ALONG THE COAST NORTH OF THE SEPIK DELTA. THE TRIBAL ART OF THIS AREA IS VERY LITTLE KNOWN AND RARELY APPEARS ON THE OPEN MARKET . IN 1898 A GERMAN ARTEFACT COLLECTOR WAS ALREADY COMPLAINING OF THE LACK OF GOOD OLD PIECES ALONG THIS COAST !
