A SMALL HIDE POUCH WITH RED AND WHITE TRIANGULAR PANELS OF BEADS. PLAINS CREE

C. SIZE : 25.5 CM LONG, 7.5 CM WIDE – 10 INS LONG, 3 INS WIDE

CIRCA 1870

A PLAINS BUFFALO HIDE WARRIORS PIGMENT BAG, CONTAINING TRACES OF RED EARTH PIGMENT USED FOR PAINTING THE FACE AND BODY. LAKOTA SIOUX. A GEOMETRIC DESIGN OF BLUE, RED AND YELLOW GLASS BEADS. THREE HIDE TASSELS TIED WITH BRASS WIRE SPIRALS.
