LITERATURE

MANY OF THE ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES OF THE ABORIGINES HAVE A RELIGIOUS OR MAGICAL BACKGROUND. CHURINGA'S ARE SACRED OBJECTS REPRESENTING THE ANCESTRAL AND INDIVIDUAL SPIRIT OF THEIR OWNER AND ARE MADE ESPECIALLY FOR USE DURING CEREMONIES. SOME ARE VERY ANCIENT AND HAVE BEEN HANDED DOWN FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION FOR AN UNKNOWN LENGTH OF TIME. MADE OF WOOD OR AN ELONGATED SLAB OF STONE THE SMALLEST KNOWN IS ONE INCH LONG AND THE LARGEST 17 FEET. WOMEN AND CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SEE THEM AND WHEN NOT IN USE THEY ARE KEPT CAREFULLY WRAPPED IN BARK OR SKINS AND HIDDEN IN SACRED PLACES.
