WORN BY INITIATED MEN AS A SYMBOL OF STATUS THESE PENDANTS ARE CALLED 'TEMA'. THE DISC IS MADE OF TRIDACNA, OR GIANT CLAM SHELL, PIERCED TO RETAIN THE HAWKSBILL TURTLE SHELL PANEL AND CUT TO RESEMBLE A STYLISED SILHOUETTE OF A FRIGATE BIRD BENEATH BONITO FISH, VISUALISED AS LOZENGERS. IN THE SOLOMAN ISLANDS THE FRIGATEBIRD IS ASSOCIATED WITH FISHING PROWESS, STRENGTH AND ENDURANCE.
