## **LITERATURE**

WHALEBONE POUNDERS WERE USED FOR SHREDDING BARK IN THE PREPARATION OF BARK RIBBONS FOR THE WEAVING OF MATS. IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT THE WOODEN BARK POUNDERS FOUND IN THE ISLANDS OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC ALSO HAVE GROOVED SURFACES.
