HE WAS INSPIRED BY THE WORK OF THE MANNERISTS AND HIS BAROQUE SCULPTURE IS REMARKABLE FOR ITS STRONG MUSCULAR PARTICULARITIES.

THE DISTINCTIVE FLARING NOSTRILS AND LARGE LIPS ARE REPEATED IN A CHRIST ON THE CROSS WITH THE VIRGIN AND ST JOHN IN MUNICH'S NATIONAL MUSEUM, AND ALSO IN A PAIR OF IVORIES SOLD BY SOTHEBY'S NEW YORK IN JAN. 1999 LOT 271.
