THE LEAVES AND FLOWERS DEPICTED IN SMALL CIRCLES AND OVALS ARE FAIRLY ABSTRACT AND COLOUR IS USED IMAGINATIVELY TO PRODUCE A MEMORABLE EFFECT. THE COMPOSITION IS BASED ON THE TRADITIONAL AND INDIGENOUS DOUBLE CURVE MOTIF.
