THE SKULL WAS AN ADMONITION TO MAN TO REFLECT ON HIS OWN END IN A TRANSIENT WORLD AND THUS BECOME LIKE THE HERMIT ST JEROME AND THE PENITENT SAINT MARY MAGDALENE BY MEDITATING ON THE SKULL AS AN EXERCISE IN CHRISTIAN REMORSE AND PENITENCE. THIS SKULL WAS PROBABLY USED AS AN OBJECT OF DEVOTIONAL CONTEMPLATION, PLACED ON A DESK OR IN A WRITING CABINET IN A STUDY.
