THIS CURIOUS BASKET WOULD HAVE TAKEN MANY WEEKS TO FORM, GROWING LAYER UPON LAYER OF ALUM CRYSTALS AROUND A WIREWORK FRAME VERY GRADUALLY.

BEFORE THE ADVENT OF CHEMICAL DYES ALUMWAS AN IMPORTANT COMPOUND USED MAINLY FOR FIXING DYES IN LEATHER. ALUMIS A COLOURLESS ASTRINGENT COMPOUND, WHICH IS A HYDRATED DOUBLE SULPHATE OF ALUMINIUM AND POTASSIUM, AND IN THE 19TH CENTURY ALUMWAS AN EXPENSIVE COMMODITY.
