ST PHILIBERT WAS AN ABBOT AND FOUNDER OF JUMIEGES (608 AD – 685 AD)

ST AUDOENUS (NOW KNOWN AS OÜEN) BECAME THE BISHOP OF ROUEN IN 641 AD (600 AD – 684 AD)

THIS SMALL DEVOTIONAL SCULPTURE WAS PROBABLY PLACED ABOVE A DOORWAY OR IS PERHAPS FROM A SMALL SIDE
CHAPEL IN A CHURCH.
