LEONARD KERN WORKED IN NAPLES AND THEN ROME BEFORE SETTLING IN HEIDELBERG, NUREMBURG AND SCHWͤBISCH HALL AND BECAME GERMANY'S LEADING MASTER OF TURNED OR CARVED IVORY. MID 17TH CENTURY EUROPE'S COURTLY TASTE HAD TURNED FROM BRONZE TO IVORY AND KERN'S STYLE REFLECTED A SHIFT FROM MANNERIST ELEGANCE AND REFINEMENT TO THE MORE ROBUST AND NATURALISTIC CLASSICISM OF THE BAROQUE.
