LITERATURE

SKULLS WERE USED IN THE MEDIEVAL WORLD AS VANITAS AND AN ADMONITORY SYMBOL. THEY WERE AN OBJECT OF DEVOTIONAL MEDITATION. ST MARY MAGDALENE IS OFTEN DEPICTED STUDYING A SKULL, AS DURING PRAYER IT BECAME A SYMBOL OF CHRISTIAN REMORSE AND PENITENCE. THE SKULL WAS A WARNING THAT MAN IS NOT DIVINE AND CANNOT ESCAPE HIS IRREVOCABLE FATE; THAT ALL EARTHLY LIFE IS TRANSIENT 'MEMENTO MORI'.
