LITERATURE

THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT THAT THESE OBJECTS WERE MADE TO BE CONTEMPLATED. CHRIST THE REDEEMER IS WEARING THE CROWN OF THORNS AND IS CONFRONTED WITH THE FACE OF DEATH, A SYMBOLIC REMINDER OF THE INCARNATION AND OF THE PASSION. THIS IVORY JANUS HEAD WAS THE TERMINAL BEAD AND WAS PROBABLY IN A TYPE OF OPEN ENDED ROSARY KNOWN AS A 'MEN'S TENNER' WHICH WAS A FAVOURITE WITH MEN IN THE LATE 17TH CENTURY.
