THE DANISH KING FREDERICK III WHO RULED FROM 1648 TO 1670 POSSESSED A TINY BOAT MADE OF NARWHAL TUSK, BUT BELIEVED TO BE OF UNICORN'S HORN AND THEREFORE ABLE TO DETECT THE PRESENCE OF POISON. MADE IN THE MID 1660'S BY JACOB JENSEN NORDMAND WHO RELATES IN HIS AUTOBIOGRAPHY: 'IN AUGUST I MADE FOR HIS MAJESTY A BOAT OF UNICORN BOUND IN GOLD. THE ANCHOR ON IT WAS ALSO MADE OF GOLD, THE SAILS WERE OF UNICORN AS THIN AS EGGHELL. IT CAN FLOAT IN A GOBLET OF WINE, FOLLOWING A MAGNET WHEREVER ONE DESIRES.' IN THE LITTLE BOAT'S PROW WAS SET A PIECE OF IRON SO THAT WITH A MAGNET ONE COULD DRAW THE BOAT AROUND THE WINE GOBLET. THIS MAGICAL MINIATURE SAILBOAT CAN STILL BE SEEN IN ROSENBERG CASTLE IN COPENHAGEN.
