THE BUDDHA IS OFTEN DEPICTED SEATED WITH A BOWL IN HIS LEFT HAND AND THE TIBETAN ALMS BOWL IS STILL ONE OF THE TRADITIONAL POSSESSIONS OF THE BUDDHIST MONK THAT IS USED TO GATHER ALMS FOR THE MONASTERY.
