LITERATURE

SEAM RUBBERS OR LINERS WERE USED BY SAILORS FOR SMOOTHING SEAMS IN CANVAS. THIS WAS ACHIEVED BY PRESSING AND RUBBING THE SHAPED END OF THE LINER AWAY FROM THE USER AND FLATTENING THE DOUBLE LINE OF WAXED TWIN STITCHES INTO THE CANVAS SO DELIBERATELY MAKING A ROW OF 'DEAD MEN'.
