WHEREAS IVORY HU WERE KEPT AS CURIOSITIES OF THE OLD CHINESE IMPERIAL COURT MOST WOODEN HU WERE DISCARDED OR LOST AND SO ARE CONSEQUENTLY NOW MUCH HARDER TO FIND.
