ALTHOUGH A POPULAR ITEM FOR THE SCRIMSHANDERS TO CRAFT THESE WALKING CANES WERE NEVER MADE TO BE USED ON BOARD SHIP. BOTH USEFUL AND ORNAMENTAL ON DRY LAND THEY WERE MOSTLY MADE TO TRADE WITH ON THE QUAYSIDE WHEN THE WHALERS RETURNED TO PORT. KNOWN AS THE 'FRIENDSHIP HAND' THE FIST WAS SYMBOLIC OF HOSPITALITY AND GOODWILL.
