NOW PROTECTED, THEY WERE HISTORICALLY FOUND BY SAILORS FLOATING MYSTERIOUSLY IN THE WARM CURRENTS OF THE SOUTH SEAS, HENCE THEIR NAME 'COCO DE MER'.
