THESE VOTIVE CARVINGS WERE KNOWN IN 16TH CENTURY SPAIN AS A 'HIGA', A FIST SHAPED AMULET THAT IS DIRECTED AGAINST THE EVIL EYE. THE THUMB AND FIRST FINGER FORMING A CHARACTERISTIC POSITION OF A 'MANO CORNUTA' OR 'POTENT GESTURE DIRECTED AGAINST EVIL'.
