KNOBKERRIES OR STAFFS CARVED OF RHINOCEROS HORN WERE RESERVED FOR USE BY CHIEFS AS SYMBOLS OF STATUS AND PERSONAL DIGNITY. USED AS PRESTIGE ITEMS IN A CHIEF'S REGALIA, STAFFS OF THIS LENGTH IN RHINOCEROS HORN WERE RARE EVEN IN THE 19TH CENTURY WHEN THERE WERE GREATER NUMBERS OF WHITE RHINOS IN SOUTHERN AFRICA AS EVIDENCED IN 1844 WHEN THE SCOTTISH BIG GAVE HUNTER ROUALEYN GORDON-CUMMING OBTAINED A LONG RHINOCEROS HORN IN EXCHANGE FOR A CUP OF GUNPOWDER FROM CHIEF SEKGOMA, THE LEADER OF THE BAWANGWATO. HE DESCRIBED IT 'AS A MOST WONDERFUL KNOBKERRIE' MADE FROM A 'VERY RARE SPECIES OF THE RHINOCEROS.... IT'S CHIEF INTEREST CONSIST IN IT'S EXTRAORDINARY LENGTH WHICH GREATLY EXCEEDED ANYTHING I HAD EVER SEEN OF THE KIND BEFORE OR HAVE SINCE MET WITH' (CUMMING LONDON 1850).
