A. ENGRAVED WITH A FIGURE OF SAINT GEORGE 'GEORGIOS' AND TO THE REVERSE THE VIRGIN WITH CHRIST CHILD AND SAINTS PETER AND PAUL ABOVE HER HEAD A GREEK INSCRIPTION 'MATER THEOS' MOTHER OF GOD

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LITERATURE

THESE EARLY BRONZE PILGRIMAGE CROSSES ARE ENGRAVED IN AN ABSTRACT LINEAR STYLE WITH EXPLICIT ICONOGRAPHY. THEY WERE MADE TO HOUSE A RELIQUARY ACQUIRED BY A PILGRIM ON HIS ARDUOUS JOURNEY TO THE HOLY LAND TO VENERATE THE SITE OF THE CRUCIFIXION AND OTHER HOLY PLACES. THE PILGRIMS WANTED BOTH A MEMENTO AND AN OBJECT REPRESENTING CHRIST'S PASSION. THESE RELIQUARY CROSSES WERE PROBABLY MADE TO ORDER FROM A STOCK OF INTERCESSORY HOLY FIGURES AND SAINTS FOLLOWING A PATTERN IN SIZE, IMAGERY AND CONSTRUCTION, BUT REFLECTING THE PILGRIMS SPECIFIC DEVOTIONAL PREDILECTIONS. THE PENDANT CROSS WAS THEN PROUDLY WORN BOTH AS AN AMULET AND TALISMANIC DEVICE FOR PROTECTION, AND AS A SACRED FOCUS FOR PRIVATE DEVOTION.
