LITERATURE

THE 'NGBANDI' ARE AN ETHNIC GROUP FROM THE REGION OF THE UPPER UBANGI RIVER, INHABITING THE NORTHERN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO AND THE SOUTHERN CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC. THE CAREFULLY BRAIDED 'OUTER' CASE PROTECTS THE USER WHILST SMOKING THE BURNING TOBACCO INSIDE THE 'TERRACOTTA' (CLAY) INNER PIPE. A FINE PATINA AND COLOUR HAVE DEVELOPED ON THE WICKER SURFACE.
