LITERATURE

AMETHYST OCCURS IN PRIMARY HUES FROM A LIGHT LAVENDER OR PALE VIOLET TO A DEEP PURPLE. THE EGYPTIANS ENGRAVED INTAGLIO GEMS. ANGLO-SAXONS GRAVES HAVE PRODUCED AMETHYST BEADS. THE ANCIENT GREEK WORD 'AMETHYSTOS' TRANSLATES AS 'NOT DRUNKEN'; AMETHYST WAS CONSIDERED TO BE A STRONG ANTIDOTE AGAINST DRUNKENNESS, HENCE WINE 'GOBLETS' WERE CARVED FROM IT.
